Action Items from the November 05, 2020 Minutes

GRE Required for Admission

Some programs have permanently removed the GRE as a requirement for admission. Some have temporarily suspended the GRE requirement. Since the Catalog states that requirement of standardized test scores is at the discretion of the program, the IGCC is asking that all programs inform them of their decisions. The Registrar's Office is maintaining a spreadsheet of the changes and is coordinating information with Graduate Admissions.

Program Deactivation

Master of Science in International Logistics

This program has not had students enrolled since 2015 and is currently not admitting students. The unit may choose to reactivate the program within the timeframe allowed if circumstances change. There is a two-year window to reactivate a program after deactivation. Beyond that timeframe, a new degree proposal would have to be submitted.
